FSI (30-50 months)	 The pupil is able to listen to religious stories with increasing attention and recall. (L) (i) In relation to RE topics, they can recognise and describe special times or events for family and friends. Context

During the Reveal section in the topic 'Celebrating', pupils learn about how the parish family celebrate. Pupils used figures/puppets/role-play to re-enact aspects of the story of Mary and Joseph taking Jesus to the temple to show that they recognise that this is a religious story.

Learning Objectives

• To recognise the story of the Presentation as a religious story about Jesus

Commentary

Pupils have re-enacted the story. Some elements of simple retell but no detail of important part of story: who they met, Simeon and Anna's words.

Context

Learning Objectives

Commentary

This pupil is clearly able to recognise elements of the Nativity story. They have also begun elements of simple retell.
