Reporting SEND

Are you concerned your child may have a special need?

NO

Not a problem. If you feel there might be something you're worried about let us know in the future.

YES

Have you spoke to your child's class teacher about it?

Start by speaking to them. If they have recently moved year group, you might want to speak to the new teacher as well.

Are you still having concerns?

NO

Great. Your child's class teacher is helping you with your concerns. If you need more help though, contact the SENDCo directly.

YES

Speak to the SENDCo directly. You can make an appointment on Class Dojo or through the office. It might be something we need you to go and see your GP about instead but we can help you with this process. If you feel you still need help contact Miss Jordan.

How we help SEND children

You may find some of our children may require additional support in lessons for their SEND, so we try various ways to help them at St. Mary's.

Every Teacher is a Teacher of SEND Pupils

Our vision 'Every Teacher is a Teacher of SEND Pupils' comes from the SEND Code of Practice. This document provides guidance for schools and explains the duties staff follow when working with SEND pupils. At St. Mary's we believe everyone in our school is responsible for supporting children with SEND. Everyone knows what SEND is. Everyone can be a teacher. Everyone can make a difference.

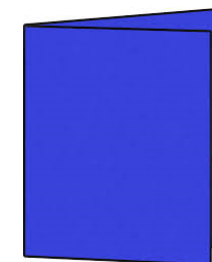
Small Group Work
