

Dear Parents,

I am so excited to be your child's first teacher!

I will do my very best to ensure that as they learn and grow, they feel happy and supported along their learning journey. It is my hope that each child will grow, learn, and develop in their own unique way and I am so excited about all the fun things we will do over the coming year!

As your child settles into school, I hope that we can work as a team to support your child in all the new things that they will learn. Please do come and speak to me, or Mrs Moore, with any questions or concerns you may have. A few reminders for you:

- Our first transition day is tomorrow. Children are in groups to attend half days on Thursday 29th August, Friday 30th August and Monday 2nd September. Your child will attend school for morning or afternoon sessions on these dates. You should have a copy of these but if you need a reminder of your child's attendance times, please contact me on dojo and I will confirm this for you.
- On Tuesday 3rd September all children will attend school from 8:35am till 1:30pm. This will be the first time they are all together and experience lunchtimes. Staff will help children choose and get their lunches at dinnertime. Please make sure you have informed us if your child has any allergies or intolerances.
- Your child only needs to bring; a coat, a bottle of water and a bookbag (plus a lunchbox if they are having a packed lunch). Please ensure these, plus items of uniform are named.
- Our PE will be on Thursday in the afternoon, so children will need to come to school dressed in their PE kits on Thursdays. This will start next week on Thursday 5th September.

Thank you for connecting to your child on Class Dojo. This is an online platform used by our school to help connect families to the classroom. This will be how I keep in touch to update you on what is happening in school and in the classroom. Next week I will also send you further information on our curriculum and learning themes for this term.

I am looking forward to working with you and helping your child settle into their first year in school.
