Happy Advent! May you and your family enjoy this time of expectant waiting and spiritual renewal.





Attendance

As we complete our journey through the school year, I wish to express my sincere gratitude and pride for the commitment shown by the St Mary's families in ensuring daily attendance and punctuality at school. High attendance and being on school on time is an important part of our children's formation. Lateness is marked on the register and school records. Our target is to reach a whole school average attendance above 98%.

The classes with the highest attendance so far this year are:

Year 4: 97%

Year 5: 96%

Year 6: 96%

Unfortunately our whole school attendance is below where it was compared to last year and we have like other schools been affected by flu and stomach bugs. We have increased the cleaning in school, bought extra supplies of hand sanitiser and staff have worn masks when they have a cold. Help us to raise attendance in school, by not booking holidays in the term time. A day off school means that gaps in learning can grow, as prior knowledge has not been taught.




